The MCVS Exam window is now open until 05 August 2022

The Bangladesh College of Veterinary Surgeons (BCVS) was established in 2019 to advance the standard of the veterinary profession in Bangladesh. BCVS administers a veterinary board examination. Successful candidates become the prestigious Member of the College of Veterinary Surgeons (MCVS). MCVS is a BVC approved qualification as recognition of excellence in knowledge and competence in veterinary medicine. Any registered veterinarian can take this examination. In 2021, ten veterinarians successfully passed the MCVS examination.

The window of the MCVS examination 2022 is now open. Interested veterinarians are invited to take this opportunity of advancing their professional qualifications to a higher level.

Dates:

The examination window is open from 18 June to 05 August 2022

Key features:

1. MCVS examination is a BVC approved veterinary board examination, administered by BCVS and operated by Prometric, an international test service provider, at their test centre in Dhaka.
2. Schedule your MCVS examination in three simple steps:
 - Enroll online at the BCVS website (<https://bcvsgbd.org/board-examination/mcvs-exam/eligibility/>)
 - Pay fees to BCVS bank account; enrollment fee Tk. 2,000 and 50% subsidized examination fee Tk. 2,000; total Tk. 4,000
 - Schedule an appointment for examination at the Prometric website at a date and time of your convenience and availability of slot before 05 August 2022.
3. MCVS examination is a computer-based MCQ test. 100 questions will be randomly assigned to each candidate by a computer programme covering both recall type and application type questions in the following disciplines:
 - Normal form and functions of animals (10%)
 - Abnormal form and functions and disease agents (20%)
 - Clinical problems (40%)
 - Animal production (10%)
 - Disease control (20%)
4. The total mark is 100 and the pass mark is 65.
5. The duration of the exam will be 2 hours 30 minutes.
6. The result will be communicated to each candidate privately by email.
7. MCVS certificate will be awarded to successful candidates in a formal ceremony.
