The undersigned Official Veterinarian certifies that the products described above satisfy the following requirements

1. The horns originate from animal which have been slaughtered for human consumption at an approved abattoir.
2. The horn has been obtained from the animals which have passed anti mortem and post mortem examination during slaughtering.
3. The horns have been sourced from country which has been placed under controlled risk category for BSE by OIE
4. The country has foot and mouth disease, and it is certified that the horns and hooves have undergone the following process:

i. The horns are completely dried and do not contain trace of horn core, skin, flesh, and extraneous tissue and have been adequately disinfected .

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- ii. The products have undergone boiling at least one hour.
- iii. After treatment, the necessary precaution has been taken to prevent contamination with potential source of pathogens.

5. The horns

- (a) Were processed in a factory registered by competent authority of the country of origin
- (b) After treatment, the necessary precaution has been taken to prevent contamination with potential source of pathogens.

6. The products have been packed in clean and disinfected bags. The vehicle in which the product was transported from approved pre-export quarantine premises to the port of departure were cleaned and disinfected with a disinfectant approved by the appropriate Veterinary authority.
